**Chester Campbell**

***The Marathon Murder Mystery***

*Gregg McKenzie Thrillstery*

Chester Campbell is making a return appearance at our book shop to sign copies of his new Greg Mckenzie mystery, *The Marathon Murder Mystery*.

Greg and Jill McKenzie take on what appears to be a 90-year-old murder case, dragging them into a present-day conspiracy filled with chicanery in circles of power and chaos created by a frenzied killer. It starts with a stash of yellowed records found during restoration of the long-defunct Marathon Motor Works' buildings in Nashville. The documents vanish, and the construction foreman who had them is murdered. The McKenzies' clients, Col. Warren Jarvis (who first appeared in *Secret of the Scroll*) and his girlfriend, Kelli Kane, believe the records would shed light on the fate of her great-great-grandfather. A Marathon officer who disappeared in 1914, he was accused of embezzlement and later found dead. More murders occur, appearing aimed at suppressing the secret behind the missing records. It's a tale of greed, misplaced pride, family loyalty, and the unpredictable violence of an irrational mind.

Mystery authors Robin Hathaway, Elena Santangelo, and Caroline Todd (half of the Charles Todd mystery-writing team) will appear at New Cumberland Library's Foundation Hall on Thursday, April 17, at 7 p.m.

Hathaway, who divides her time between Philadelphia and New York City, is the author of the Doctor Andrew Fenimore series, featuring an old-fashioned cardiologist who still makes house calls, and the Jo Banks series, starring a young woman doctor who provides medical services at motels and makes her own house calls on motorcycle, in the wilds of New Jersey. Hathaway's first book, the *Doctor Digs a Grave*, won the St. Martin's Malice Domestic Contest for Best Traditional Mystery. Published by St. Martin's Press in 1998, the book also won an Agatha Award.

Santangelo writes the Pat Montella mystery series, which is set in Virginia. The first book in the series, *By Blood Possessed*, is a captivating Civil War story which mixes past and present conflicts, with an overlay of magical realism. There are two more books in the se-

ries, the most recent of which is *Poison To Purge Melancholy*. An award-winning short story writer, Elena lives in Norristown.

Caroline Todd is half of an internationally-acclaimed mother and son writing team who live on the East Coast and write the Ian Rutledge series, which began in 1996 with *A Test Of Wills*. Rutledge, a Scotland Yard detective, has returned from World War I, the so-called Great War, haunted by memories of the battlefield, and the acerbic voice of a young soldier he was forced to execute. Nine books later, Rutledge continues the struggle to heal his wounded soul, and to regain the brilliance of his earlier career.

*Jeff Abbott* - \$7.99

After his friend is killed in a shootout, federal witness Miles Kendrick becomes a haunted man. While helping his doctor with a mysterious favor, Miles stumbles upon an illegal research program that could free him—and millions of others suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder—from crippling memories.

**Never End - Chief Inspector Erik Winter Mystery 2**  
*Laurie Thompson and Ake Edwardson* - \$14.00

Detective Erik Winter chases a copycat murderer, hunting for a link bridging the current violence to an unsolved rape and murder that occurred five years earlier.

**Walla Walla Suite: Room with No View - Quinn Mystery 2**

*Anne Argula* - \$12.95

The author of the Edgar Award-nominated *Homicide My Own* presents another off-beat adventure. Quinn, a divorced ex-cop, retains custody of her wild hot flashes, twisted tongue, fey sense of humor, and her propensity for trouble. In his novel, "The Sixth Lamentation," William Brodrick introduced Father Anselm, the barrister turned monk who was plunged into the tangled history of occupied Paris. In "The Gardens of the Dead," Father Anselm is brought back to his own past at the Bar, and someone else's secrets. Elizabeth Glendinning QC has lost faith in the legal system to which she has given her life. Trying to restore it, she has devised a scheme to bring a guilty man back to court. As part of a contingency plan, Elizabeth leaves Anselm with a safety deposit box, to be opened in the event of her death. Three weeks later she is found dead in the East End of London. Opening the box triggers a chain of events that leads Anselm to fulfill what Elizabeth has begun.

**The Hounds and the Fury - Jane Arnold Mystery 5**

*Rita Mae Brown* - \$13.95

Brown fifth thrilling mystery of murder and splendor in Virginia fox hunting country—the first to focus on the beloved hounds.

The death of a carpenter strikes Erin close to home, while a dangerous beauty wants to get much too close to Sullivan. Includes home-decorating tips.

**Chocolate Jewel Case - Chocoholic Mystery 7**

*JoAnna Carl* - \$6.99

When the town of Warner Pier has a jewel heist, and then a body is found in the lake, Lee McKinney Woodyard wonders if the crimes are related. Maybe if she digs up some dirt, she'll hit the mother lode. Includes tasty chocolate trivia.

**Village Affairs - Phillip Bethancourt and Jack Gibbons Mystery 2**

*Cassandra Chan* - \$6.99

Scotland Yard detective Sergeant Jack Gibbons hears about the death of a widower in Chipping Chedding, and can't believe his luck. His best friend, Phillip Bethancourt, just so happens to be in Chipping Chedding already. Though Bingham's death appears to have been accidental, Jack and Phillip begin to suspect foul play. **Motif for Murder - Scrapbook Mystery 4***Laura Childs - \$6.99*

**The Drowning Man - Wind River Reservation Mystery 12***Margaret Coel, - \$7.99*

Arapaho attorney Vicky Holden and Father John O'Malley find themselves in the dark underbelly of the illegal market for Indian relics, in this installment of Coel's bestselling Native American mystery series.

**Dragon Fire***William S Cohen - \$7.99*

Upon the assassination of the Secretary of Defense, former senator and Vietnam POW, Michael Patrick Santini, is called upon by his President to fill the vacancy. Once there, he discovers that the US is under attack by a silent, sinister force, someone determined to alienate our allies and undermine our position as a global superpower. But America is hours away from going to war—with the wrong enemy. Rejecting direct orders from the president, Santini races across the world in an attempt to prevent a global war.

**Echo Park - Harry Bosch Mystery 12***Michael Connelly - \$7.99*

Detective Harry Bosch reopens one of his own unsolved cases and comes face to face with a killer he has been seeking for 11 years. When Bosch realizes he and his partner missed a clue that could have prevented 9 additional murders, his whole being as a cop begins to crack.

**Crisis***Robin Cook - \$9.99*

The bestselling author and master of the medical thriller now shows readers a healer's dark side, in the terrifying story of a doctor who plunges into a web of corruption and lies.

**The One Minute Assassin***Troy Cook - \$14.95*

The strangest election in California history is about to get weirder, as 1 of the 100 unusual candidates running for governor starts to kill his way to the top. All of the candidates are suspects, and former P.I. John Black charges into this wild political world to find the culprit.

**The Meaning of Night - A Confession***Michael Cox - \$14.95*

On an October 1854 night, a man is stabbed to death. So begins the story of Edward Glyver, booklover, scholar and murderer. As a boy, Glyver always believed he was

destined for greatness. This seems the stuff of dreams, until a chance discovery convinces Glyver that he was right: greatness does await him. Glyver's path leads him from the depths of Victorian London, to Evenwood, one of England's most enchanting country houses. His is a story of betrayal and treachery, of death and delusion, of ruthless obsession and ambition.

**The Musketeer's Apprentice - Musketeer Mystery 3***Sarah D Almeida - \$6.99*

Searching for his apprentice's killer, Musketeer Porthos rallies his friends to discover who is responsible, even as he puts his own life in danger.

**Saks & Violins - Bed-and-Breakfast Mystery 22***Mary Daheim - \$6.99*

Music, murder, and mayhem take the center stage in this latest entry in the charming B&B series. The harder Judith digs into a murder and a crime spree, the more frustrated she becomes. If she doesn't find the killer fast, this investigation might be her swan song.

**Retribution - Dreamland Mystery 9***Jim DeFelice & Dale Brown - \$7.99*

The Dreamland team races to recover missing nuclear warheads from militant Islamists, who have targeted Las Vegas for destruction.

**The Witch Is Dead - Ophelia and Abby Mystery 5***Shirley Damsgaard - \$6.99*

When a dog belonging to Tink, the medium Ophelia Jensen is preparing to adopt, pulls a skull from the woods, Ophelia hesitates to begin an investigation. However, Tink has been having visions of ghosts calling for help. Before Ophelia can connect the apparitions to a possible murder, Tink is kidnapped.

**Tombs of Endearment - Pepper Martin Mystery 3***Casey Daniels - \$6.99*

Pepper Martin, the former spoiled rich girl who sees dead people and now works as a cemetery tour guide, returns for her third mystery and becomes embroiled in the investigation of the murder of a long-dead rock star.

**Obsession, Deceit and Really Dark Chocolate - Sophie Katz Mystery 3***Kyra Davis - \$13.95*

Sophie is enlisted by her friend to spy on her husband, a political campaign adviser who ends up dead. When she plunges into a world of political maneuvering and sexual fetishes, Sophie turns to P.I. Anatoly Darinsky for help.

**Shadows in Bronze - Marcus Didius Falco Mystery 2***Lindsey Davis - \$6.99*

Marcus Didius Falco, Ancient Rome's favorite son and palace spy, has just been left in the dust by the beautiful, high-born Helena Justina. When the Emperor Vespasian calls upon him to investigate an act of treason, Falco soon uncovers a dangerous conspiracy—one in which Helena may be involved.

**Stone Butterfly - Charlie Moon Mystery 11***James D Doss - \$6.99*

An elderly man is murdered and the suspect is an orphaned girl whose father was a childhood friend of the victim—Charlie Moon and FBI Special Agent Lila Mae McTeague take on the case.

**The Next Killing***Rebecca Drake - \$6.99*

When a twisted psychopath starts murdering students at an exclusive girls academy, a teacher risks her life to put a stop to it, in this chilling thriller by the author of "Don't Be Afraid."

**Havoc***Jack B Du Brul - \$7.99*

On a stormy night in 1937, the German zeppelin "Hindenburg" flies over rural New Jersey. Her appointment with destiny is still a few hours away, but death already walks her decks. A madman has traveled across the Atlantic bearing a locked safe—inside, a secret so terrible that it may change the course of history.

**Blood Poison - C.S.U. Investigation Mystery 2***D H Dublin - \$7.99*

The death-by-overdose of an environmentalist comes as a shock to almost everyone. The more forensics detective Madison Cross investigates, the less sense his death makes. But as she entangles herself in the web of the man's perverse family, Madison realizes, that the killer is honing in on her.

**Face Down O'er the Border - Susanna, Lady Appleton Mystery 10***Kathy Lynn Emerson - \$14.95*

It is 1557 and Mary Queen of Scots is a prisoner in England, and Scotland is in upheaval. Does this political unrest tie in with a murder involving Susanna Appleton's friend Catherine, who has disappeared in the company of a spy, and is now under suspicion of treason?

**Downforce - Stockcar Mystery 2***Steve Eubanks - \$6.99*

Robert Redball Redding, a former car racing superstar who now prosecutes bad guys, returns in this compelling crime thriller set in the world of stock car racing.

**Bon Bon Voyage - Culinary Mystery 9***Nancy Fairbanks - \$6.99*

Even if Carolyn Blue has to share a cabin with her mother-in-law, she'll still enjoy her Mothers Day present: a gourmet European cruise. That is, until a female passenger and a chocolate mousse go missing. Includes authentic French recipes.

**The Fourth Bear - Nursery Crime Mystery 2***Jasper Fforde - \$14.00*

In the second adventure by the bestselling author of the Thursday Next novels, "nursery crime" characters Jack Spratt and Mary Mary take on their most dangerous case so far, as a murderous cookie (The Gingerbread Man) menaces the streets of Reading.

**Three Strikes and You're Dead - Murder, She Wrote Mystery 26***Jessica Fletcher - \$6.99*

The son of the owner of a AA-league baseball team in Arizona is murdered, and one of the teams players—the son of the old friends Jessica is visiting—is suspected. Jessica starts looking into the case and soon finds that for some people, baseball is not just a game.

**Under Orders - Sid Halley Mystery 4***Dick Francis - \$9.99*

Sid Halley, former jockey-turned-detective, returns. Death at the races is not uncommon, but three in one day—including a winning horse and champion jockey—are more than enough to raise Halley's suspicions.

**Stealing Lumby - Lumby Mystery 2***Gail Fraser - \$14.00*

What Garrison Keillor does for Lake Wobegon, Gail Fraser has done for Lumby, in this series. Lumby wasn't always the sleepy, hidden town its residents have loved for decades. Back in the 1950s, it had a moment of fame when artist Dana Porter made two of its picturesque barns the subject of one of his greatest paintings. The town is jolted from its comfortable obscurity once again when the famous painting disappears. Things go from bad to worse when one of the barns goes missing, and the town's residents try to decide what to make of it all. As the story unfolds—pieces of the stolen barn show up in the strangest of places, a schooner goes sailing down Main Street, and the famous artist recreates his masterpiece in a way that surprises all.

**A Play of Lords - Joliffe Mystery 4***Margaret Frazer - \$7.99*

Reason returned, but convoluted politics barred her release. Embarrassment repressed the statewide sensation that newspapers predicted to become "one of the most famous criminal cases in Virginia."

## Ravin' From Ruth

Our good friend Ruth Greiner sends us book reviews each month, which we have available at the shop. Follows her "ravings" for March. Thank you Ruth!

March has come in, looking and acting like April, with lots of showers to green us up for St. Patrick's Day. So staying inside and reading is still a good thing to do, and that's what I have done. My list, this month, is pretty evenly divided between British and U.S. authors.

To start with, then, across the Atlantic: Five titles from Charles Todd's Inspector Ian Rutledge series, which takes place just after World War I and chronicles a man's struggles to recover from the physical and emotional trauma of that terrible time. I started at the beginning, with *A Test Of Wills* (1996), and have progressed through *Wings Of Fire*, *Search the Dark*, *Legacy of the Dead*, and *Watchers Of Time* (2001). This is a remarkable series, which combines well-thought-out mysteries, wonderfully-realized characters, and a searching look at the social ills spawned by the Great War. The sense of place and time are particularly well-done, as Rutledge, haunted by his actions during the war, is posted to various parts of Great Britain at the behest of a supervisor who is anxious for him to fail.

In a lighter vein, and in our own century, M.C. Beaton's *Death Of A Gentle Lady* is the twenty-third in the Hamish MacBeth Highland mystery series, and poor Hamish is hard put to keep the women folk straight as he tries to solve the murder of a cruel woman and the death of a Russian émigré, whilst balancing the attentions of a Russian policewoman and his lady friends Priscilla and Elspeth, and keeping ahead of Inspector Blair. He does it all, of course, and con-

tinues his love affair with his job and his town. Moving southward, in Rebecca Tope's *A Cotswold Mystery*, a house-sitter confronts murder and lots of family ties, with a little help from her conveniently situated policewoman daughter.

Back here, I weathered a couple of hurricanes, in Carolyn Hart's *Dead Man's Island* (1993), the first in her "Henrie O" series, and in Margaret Maron's *Storm Track* (2000), the seventh in her Judge Deborah Knott series. Both novels stood the test of time, and vividly illustrated the effects of a violent storm, from uprooted trees to snakes in the rafters. I also read Hart's *Skulduggery* (1984), a romance-thriller set in San Francisco's Chinatown and featuring an exciting anthropological discovery. It predates Hart's popular Max and Annie Darling series, and is a nice warm-up exercise for this very popular author.

Bouncing around the country, there was the late Phyllis Whitney's *Emerald* (1982), a look at a woman in flight from an abusive husband who becomes caught up in a web of deceit and greed out in Palm Springs. Then came Martha Grimes' *Dakota*, the second appearance of Andi Oliver, an amnesiac animal activist. This is an engaging and compelling character--she's on her way to Alaska, and it's going to be interesting watching her get there.

Down in Tennessee, "Bone Farm" doctor Bill Brockton makes his third appearance in *The Devil's Bones*, uncovering funeral home fraud, working to convict a murderer, and keeping ahead of an escaped killer who's bent on revenge. Another nice series, with engaging characters and tricky plots, with some education on the side. And up in Maine, Sarah Grave's character Jacobia Tip-tree gives us some tips on restoring a 19th-century

house even as she finds herself once again in the midst of murder and mayhem in *The Book of Old Houses*. This is the eleventh title in this series, and "Cabot Cove syndrome" may set in at some point, but so far, Jake and company keep us reading.

Finally, two authors a little closer to home: Elena Santangelo's *By Blood Possessed* (1999) introduces Pat Montella, who learns she's going to inherit some property in Virginia but finds it haunted by Confederate ghosts and a few dishonest contemporary folks. And Robin Hathaway's *Scarecrow* (2003) introduces a new series character, Dr. Jo Banks, who makes her housecalls in the "wilds of New Jersey" on motorcycle, and dabbles in the occasional mystery along the way.

Then, along with some friends, I revisited Nancy Drew, starting with *The Secret Of the Old Clock* (1930) and *The Hidden Staircase* (1930), the first two books in the series. Nostalgia kicked in right away, and the innocence of that time was quite amazing (as was the willingness of every policeman to help Nancy along the way). *The Clue In the Crossword Cipher* (1967), set in Peru, and *The Mystery Of the Moss-Covered Mansion* (1971), set in Florida, were fun to read and not very believable, but Nancy and friends sure have a good time! Melanie Rehak's *Girl Sleuth: Nancy Drew and the Women Who Created Her* (2005) is an even-handed look at the creation of the series and its fortunes up to the present--it's as much fun as the mysteries themselves.

One more fun read: Alan Bennett's *The Uncommon Reader*, the story of what happens when a royal monarch visits the bookmobile that's parked behind Buckingham Palace. Quite lovely!
